**Carole Bennett** – 1944

Brought up in Burton, Carole paints with oils, selling limited edition prints of her landscapes and still-life's of fruit.

**Jane Burns** – 1081

Born and bred in Burton Jane has taught adults a range of crafts including needlework and felting. She sells some of her work.

**Sue Cooper** – 3043

Having moved to Burton 7 years ago for a quieter pace of life and to enjoy a freedom of expression through her art, Sue uses pastels for her landscapes and human and animal portraiture. Her work is for sale.

**Karl Dixon** – 07985589340

Part-time resident of Burton and a recent photography graduate Karl is based in Lancaster's Storey Centre where he works as a free-lance photographer. Available for weddings, photo-shoots, family portraiture (recently had a family portrait day in village hall), gigs etc.
